#### **Did You Know?**

On May 8, 2010, actress Betty White, 88 at the time, became the oldest person to host "Saturday Night Live." Hundreds of thousands of people had joined a Facebook campaign rallying for White to host the comedy sketch show. She won the seventh Emmy Award of her career for her "SNL" appearance. Born in Oak Park, Ill., in 1922, Betty Marion White attended high school in Beverly Hills, Calif., before launching her career as an actress, host and producer in radio and television. White played "happy homemaker" Sue Ann Nivens on "The Mary Tyler Moore Show," and later co-starred on "The Golden Girls" as the sweet and naïve Rose Nylund from St. Olaf, Minn. After the series ended, White continued to display her comedic talent in a long list of films and TV shows before her death in December 2021 at the age of 99.
